Interlibrary Loan Policy

Interlibrary Loan (ILL) is an agreement among libraries to share materials by borrowing and lending to each other. The policies detailed in the current *Illinet Interlibrary Loan Code* of Illinois, and all other applicable regional and state interlibrary loan policies will be observed. The Interlibrary Loan policy does not pertain to reciprocal borrowing or the exchange of materials between MAGIC libraries.

Materials are available to Poplar Creek Public Library District (PCPLD) cardholders by request from other libraries provided the materials are not owned by the PCPLD. Patrons are responsible for paying any fees assessed by the lending library, any shipping fees incurred in obtaining the loaned item(s) and full replacement costs plus any applicable processing fee if an item is lost, damaged, or not returned. Additional ILL requests will not be accepted until these costs are paid in full.

Materials available to loan:

- Books
- Music CDs
- Audio books
- DVDs
- Articles

Materials not available for loan:

- Items less than six (6) months old
- Video games
- Reference material
- E-resources
- Reference
- Periodicals

Photocopies/Facsimiles/Email

- Up to ten (10) pages may be photocopied, faxed and/or scanned, within copyright limits, and sent via regular mail, fax and/or email.

Loan Periods and Renewal

- May have up to 10 item requests in process at one time.
- Due dates and renewals are set by the lending library
- Renewals must be requested through the Interlibrary Loan Department
- Overdue fines for loans will be calculated according to the PCPLD Fines and Fees policy for overdue items.
